The Sunset Empire Park & Recreation District is requesting proposals for services of a licensed public accountant or accounting firm whose principal officers performing the audit are independent Certified Public Accountants, with a municipal audit license issued by the State of Oregon, to perform the auditing services listed below with the option of auditing its financial statements for each of the three subsequent years if the District is completely satisfied with the service provided.

An audit of the accounts and financial affairs of the District for fiscal periods from July 1<sup>st</sup>, through June 30<sup>th</sup> of each year must be conducted in accordance with the State of Oregon Minimum Standards for Audits of Oregon Municipal Corporations (ORS Chapter 297.465, et seq. [1983]).

Sunset Empire Park & Recreation District is a special district in Seaside, Oregon that was organized on February 14, 1969 and is operating under the provision of the Oregon revised Statues 266 to provide Park & Recreation services. Services include Sunset Pool, Broadway Field, Seaside Youth Center, Bob Chisholm Community Center, sports & fitness activities, special events, and management of the District. Sources of revenue include fees for services, grants, and property taxes. The District has a total of four (4) funds. The District's operating budget for the last three (3) years has averaged \$2.84 million dollars.
