

Results of the Community Needs Assessment


The opportunity to provide feedback on community needs and the acquisition of the Broadway Middle School building was shared with the public in a number of ways:

- Social Media
- SEPRD Website
- Article in Seaside Signal
- Meetings with community organizations
- Partnership with the city of Seaside to distribute in water bills

We estimate 3,000+ community members received this invitation, and 359 provided feedback, 89% of whom were district residents. This 10% response rate is on par with national response rates.


This survey measured community support for acquisition of the building to expand services, for three objectives put forth by the Board of Directors, and for meeting community needs.

Acquisition of BMS Building Support: 65.45% Neutral: 4.21% Oppose: 28.65%





Increase Child Care, Preschool, & After-School Programs to Support Local Working Families




OBJECTIVE #2
