

Public Notice: Intent to Sell SEPRD Bounce House

Issued by: Sunset Empire Park & Recreation District

The Sunset Empire Park & Recreation District (SEPRD) is a local government established by the residents of the District in 1969 under ORS 198 and governed by a five-member elected Board of Directors. The Board of Directors established and adopted a "Surplus Property Policy" in February 2024 which provides guidance for the disposal of items that are no longer of use to the District or no longer have value. The policy requires the District to dispose of the item(s) in the manner that is most advantageous to the District and/or the community at large.

In adherence with the policy, SEPRD is disposing of its "bounce house". A bounce house is a large, springy, inflatable structure that is filled with air and designed for fun, often used at parties, festivals and other events.

The SEPRD bounce house is approximately 15 years old and, when inflated, takes up an area approximately 13ft wide x 11ft long x 11ft high with a 3ft entrance ramp. The bounce house includes a hand cart to transport, and an electric blower used in the inflation and operation of the bounce house.

SEPRD is selling the item "as is" and there will be no refunds after the sale. The winning bidder will be responsible for arranging pickup of the item after payment has been received.

Interested parties can submit their interest in writing with their proposed bid. While SEPRD values the bounce house at \$500, we request that minimum bids are at least \$250. It is the intent of SEPRD to award the bounce house to the highest bidder. Bidding will close on Friday, May 31, 2024 at 5:00 pm PDT. Late bids will not be considered.
