



Community Needs Assessment

Overview

- Survey shared to obtain feedback on community needs and acquisition of Broadway Middle School building
- Number of responses: 359
- 89.36% of respondents were district residents



Priorities

- Expand indoor recreation activities for all citizens
- Increase desperately needed child care, preschool, and after-school activities
- Contribute to local economy through a sports tourism strategy



Summary of Support

- Acquisition of BMS building: 65.45%
- Expand indoor recreation activities for all citizens: 68.61%
- Increase child care, preschool, and after-school activities: 68.68%, 66.37%, 71.88%
- Sports tourism strategy: 61.78%



Support for Youth Programs

- Summer Camps: 71.85%
- Youth Open Gym Time: 69.85%
- Pottery and Arts Classes: 65.60%
- Maker Classes: 65.80%
- Technology Access: 66.48%



Support for Adult Programs

- Senior Meals: 71.59%
- Senior Social Activities: 69.65%
- Pottery and Arts Classes: 60.94%
- Maker Classes: 61.95%
- Sewing/Knitting Classes: 56.14%
- Technology Access: 62.03%
- Meditation/Wellness: 61.22%
- Support Services: 62.90%
- Meeting Space: 63.87%



Support for Sports/Recreation

- Indoor Weight Training: 63.27%
- Strength/Conditioning Classes: 64.53%
- Pickleball: 49.57%
- Basketball: 62.32%
- Volleyball: 61.63%
- Soccer: 60.17%
- Dodgeball/Kickball: 51.76%



Support for Sports/Recreation

- Indoor Track: 67.93%
- Outdoor Track: 65.37%
- Yoga: 62.06%
- Outdoor Fitness: 60.0%
- Hiking Tours: 58.82%
- Special Events: 65.81%



Use and Support

- Likely to Use: 66.38%
- Public Trust: 63.68%



Conclusion

Based on the quantitative data, the majority of respondents support expanding services and the acquisition of the BMS building.
